



Drainage – Cowdray Park Polo Club



Project details:

For a club that plays in excess of 450 matches per season including the Veuve Clicquot Gold Cup for the British Open Polo Championship and the St Regis international polo test match, ensuring that playing fields are in pristine condition and that games aren't affected by waterlogged pitches is paramount.

Faced with increasingly wetter summers, Cowdray Park is tackling this by improving drainage. Contractor Amtrac Ambersham chose Lytag[®] 4/8mm lightweight aggregate as the best material for this project as it has excellent drainage characteristics - the material will quickly soak up water and the materials' round and consistent grading enables water to filter away easily.

The surface drainage system has proven to be ideal for their purposes, as it allows quick and even drainage and helps to maintain playing pitches of the highest quality.
